

▲ CNA CNPP Rules and Regulations

The following rules and regulations apply to the Colorado Nurses Association (CNA) Champions for Nursing Partnership Program (CNPP). All CNA CNPP participants must adhere to these rules and regulations to ensure a mutually beneficial partnership.

- I. CNA expects each partner to maintain proper decorum. Partners are expected to conduct and promote themselves in a manner that contributes to the mutual advancement of CNA and the partner.
- II. Partners are not allowed to speak on behalf of CNA.
- III. Partners are not to market products for purchase to members of CNA.
- IV. Partners are not allowed to share or sell CNA member information.
- V. CNA reserves the right to edit or omit any submitted materials prior to releasing to CNA members.
- VI. The use of profanity is not allowed in communications, marketing materials, or articles.
- VII. Partners may not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, disability, marital status, or political affiliation.

Failure to follow the CNA CNPP Rules and Regulations will result in termination of the partnership without a refund of payment.
